WELCOME OGDEN PIONEER DAYS HORSE AND HITCH PARADE PARTICIPANTS!



We are excited for your participation with us in the Ogden Pioneer Days Horse & Hitch Parade which runs through the heart of Ogden City to celebrate Utah's statehood and the heritage of our area. It is intended for individual and family audiences, including children. We are excited to see how the changes this year will work and appreciate your help in creating a great atmosphere and a fun filled day spent together enjoying our horse community. Please follow the instructions below for the Horse & Hitch Parade.

1. Every entry and participant must be covered by their own liability insurance.

Neither Ogden City, Ogden Pioneer Days Foundation or Ogden Pioneer Days provides insurance for parade participants.

- 2. All entries will be positioned in the parade lineup at the discretion of the Horse & Hitch Parade Director so the parade can be staged for the audience.
- 3. If you are just dropping off participants and not horses, please drop off on Grant Ave and have them walk to Washington Blvd.
- 4. Horse unloading will be in the west 2 lanes of Washington Blvd from Franklin Street to Goddard Street. (See map on back). Please unload and move your trailers as quickly as possible. **Note:** there is no horse trailer parking in the empty lot on 30th & Grant.
- 5. Horse trailers must be moved to the end of the parade route. There is parking for horse trailers blocked off on Washington Blvd from 17th to the river bridge.
- 6. Please clean up after your horses while unloading and loading to be respectful.
- 7. We will be using Alphabetical letters for lineup and they will be provided at the Sign-in table at the southwest corner of 31st Street starting at 8:00 am.
- 8. The Horse & Hitch Parade lineup area will be on Washington Blvd between 30th and 32nd. Please use the west side of Washington Blvd to get from drop off to parade lineup area as the Grande Parade lineup will be on the east side of Washington Blvd.
- 9. All entries must be in their respective places at the 8:45 am.
- 10. No items or objects may be sprayed, thrown (i.e., candy, fliers, toys, water, etc.) to parade spectators from any parade entry.
- 11. Please maintain spacing of fifteen (15) feet between entries and do not hinder the pace of the parade in any way.
- 12. When the road has a divider in the middle, there will be someone there to direct you on which side of the divider you are to go on.
- 13. Please be prepared for the Flyover at 10:00 am and dismount or have control of your horse or team during the flyover.
